General Description

CALL is a Spanish language-learning program where you study and live on the beautiful and safe seminary campus in San Jose, Costa Rica. You will develop relationships with Hispanic students and missionaries, learn the language and culture as well as experience the wonders of Costa Rica, known worldwide for its lush vegetation and natural beauty. Your knowledge of Spanish will grow as you take part in small group classes for 3 hours a day, 5 days a week with additional study time provided each day.

Package Details

- **Seminary:** 15-acre campus on a park-like setting, 24-hour guard, soccer field, basketball hoop, student laundry facility, ping-pong table, and plenty of space for walking and enjoying the scenic views of Costa Rica. The average temperature is 75 degrees year round. December–May are dry months while June–November are rainy.
- **Housing:** Apartment and dorm style housing with 1 bathroom, normally shared with Latino students. Rooms hold up to 8 students. Married couples have their own apartment, for an additional cost, as space allows.
- **Services:** Airport transportation provided, Internet access at Seminary Library, grocery store across the street, taxis and buses available at front gate, local Nazarene church on campus. The water in San Jose is drinkable from the tap.
- **Food:** If you attend during Intensives, you will eat in the dining hall. At all other times of the year, students prepare their own food. Apartments have a kitchen with stovetop, oven and refrigerator as well as basic cookware, plates, cups and utensils. When the dining hall is open during non-Intensive courses, you may purchase meals for a reasonable fee. Included in package price: \$100 per week for food. If you spend more than \$100 per week, this additional cost is your personal responsibility.
- **Spanish Classes:** Experienced Latino professors teach individual or small group classes. All levels of Spanish can be taught based on your needs. Classes are three hours a day, five days a week.
- **Tourism:** Costa Rica offers a variety of tourism sites: the beautiful beaches, volcanoes, coffee plantations, butterfly farms, La Paz Waterfall gardens, hot springs near Volcan Arenal and canopy tours. These activities are not part of the package price, but we encourage you to take in the sites of Costa Rica on the weekends.
- **Ministry:** When local churches hold ministry activities such as church planting projects and evangelism/compassion outreach activities, you may choose to participate. These projects normally include VBS with children, construction, painting projects and/or the Jesus Film.
- **Insurance:** Basic insurance with Global Mission is required, but not included as part of the package. You will pay this online with Global Mission. (\$2.75 per day when you stay for 22 days or more).

Package Price for 4 weeks (15 hours of individual or small group class time each week): **\$1530.00**

Not included: Airfare to San Jose, insurance, textbook, exit tax (\$26.00), optional tourism activities.
